New Holland Rochester Earns Farm Equipment's Prestigious 2014 "Best-in-Class Dealership" Award

BROOKFIELD, WIS. — July 14 — New Holland Rochester in Rochester, Ind., has been selected as the 2014 "Best-in-Class Farm Equipment Dealership" by Farm Equipment magazine.
